We suggest you to teach your ward the value of time and time management at large.

You are advised to follow the school timing accordingly and pick /drop your ward on time Late arrivals will not be entertained. Do not let your ward take leave from school for flimsy reasons.

- Parents are requested to send their ward to school in neat and prescribed uniform, polished shoes, trimmed hair and nails. P.T uniform is to be worn by students of Std. III to VII on every Wednesday and Saturday and by the students of Nursery to Std. II on every Thursday respectively.
- Parents must ensure that their ward carry books according to the time table. All the books and note books should be covered with brown paper & labelled with name & class. Bags, water bottles, pencil boxes, should be marked with indelible ink for identification (Use of plastic items is strictly prohibited).
- > Parents must go through the rules and regulations and other contents mentioned in the school diary. All the desired information of the school diary should be filled up as soon as the child gets it. You are requested to check the diary of your ward at regular intervals. Any changes in residential address & telephone numbers should be intimated to the school.
- > Those students whose fees are in arrear more than two consecutive months his/her name will be struck off the rolls.
- Request, if any, for Transfer Certificate (T.C) must be made on/before 10<sup>th</sup> April 2025, otherwise full school fee for the month of April will have to be deposited if a request for T.C, is made after aforesaid date.
- Students who avail transport facility must strictly observe the rules of school transport. Transport charges are to be paid for only eleven months in one academic year. No request to discontinue the bus facility will be entertained during the academic year.

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- Parents are reminded to ensure the safety of their wards while fixing private transport (Autorickshaw, Van e.t.c.) School will not be responsible for any untoward happening.
- > Parents should not take their children home during school hours.

### **Guidelines on Payment of fees**
